Introduction Lesson

1. Morphology Drill	Morphology card review deck used. Use gestures.	3-4 minutes
2. Concept Revision	Concept and rule reciting	2 minutes
3. New Teaching Point	Introduce New Morpheme. Rehearse meaning and gesture.	3-4 minutes
4. Words to Build	Slides with clue sentences for words containing the new morpheme. These words are written on worksheet or in student's Lexicon workbook.	5 minutes
5. Words to Read	6-8 words to read including the new morpheme.	1-2
6. Dictation	1-2 Sentences	5 minutes
7. Sentence Creation	Student's create their own sentence including at least 1 of the words from their lexicon list.	3-4 minutes
8. Connected Text	Fluency Work - <i>I Read, We Read, You Read</i> , Choral Read or Paired Reading. Text includes words from phonology (Phases 2-4) and the new morpheme.	3-4 minutes
9. Vocabulary	1-3 Words from Connected Text - when required	1-2 minutes

1. Morphology Drill	Morphology card review deck used. Use gestures.	3-4 minutes
2. Concept Revision	Concept and rule reciting.	2 minutes
3. Morpheme Revision	Slides with clue sentences for words. containing morphemes previously taught.	4-5 minutes
4. Word Sums	Write complete word on whiteboard	4 minutes
5. Words to Read	6-8 words to read from the word sums.	1-2
6. Let's Use It	A range of activities/games.	5 minutes
7. Vocabulary	1-3 Words from Connected Text - when required	1-2 minutes
